


Building integrated capacity in autism and mental health

Survey Instruction Sheet

This work will help us move towards Building Integrated Capacity in Autism and Mental Health. Brief instructions are provided below to support you in completing this survey. **Please note:** This survey takes 30-40 minutes to complete and closes on Friday July 30 at 5pm EDT.

1. Click the survey link that was provided to you by your agency/organization/association.

Introduction: Thank you for sharing your opinions and experiences with us. This survey will help us gather information about your training, background and knowledge towards treating children and youth with mental health problems **who also present with Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD) and Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD)**. We are interested in learning this to help inform future training opportunities.

2. Once you have opened the link, an information and consent page will appear. Please read carefully. You will be prompted to agree to the consent terms.

- 3. Start the survey by filling out information about your role as a provider in a private practice (e.g., part-time or full-time). You will also be prompted with a question to provide geographical/regional information.**

- 4. Begin survey and respond to questions. This survey takes 30-40mins. Your responses are anonymous.**

As a reminder, this survey has questions pertaining to both ADHD and ASD. Please answer to the best of your abilities. Once you begin the survey, it is best that you complete it all at once. If you have cookies allowed on your browser, the survey MAY automatically save some of your responses in a situation where your computer crashes or you do not complete it. If you click on the original link again and use the same browser, it MAY bring you back to the point that you last stopped. We are saying it MAY do that because depending on your computer, internet, and browser settings, the survey system may not be able to identify where you last left off. That is why you should complete it in one attempt.

- 5. Complete the survey from a computer.**

Do not use your phone. Using your phone will make responding more difficult because of how the survey is displayed.

- 6. At the end of the survey, click 'Submit Responses' to submit your survey responses.**
